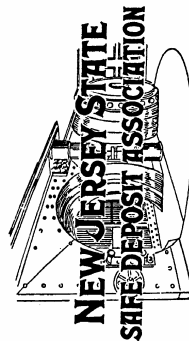


From North or South Jersey:

- Must the bank turn all abandoned property over to the State?
- How can a bank recoup costs associated with abandoned boxes?
